

Resolution 2017-4B. On Adopting a Proposed Departmental Reorganization – Department of Cariology and Restorative Sciences.

The Faculty of the School of Dentistry enact that:

Section 1. The Department of Operative Dentistry and the Department of Prosthodontics are to be consolidated into a new department, to be called the Department of Cariology and Restorative Sciences, pending the approval of the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill Board of Trustees. This department will house divisions of: biomaterials, comprehensive (general) dentistry, operative dentistry and prosthodontics.

The Faculty further charge the Constitution and Bylaws Committee to draft changes to the Constitution of the School of Dentistry to appropriately form and define this Department, with the understanding that such changes must be approved by the Faculty in order to take effect.

Section 2. The changes outlined in Sections 1, if approved, are to be effective July 2018 and are to be reflected in the school's Constitution (Article III, Section 4) at that time.
