

## **Resolution 2017-5. On Initiating an International DDS Program.**

The Faculty of the School of Dentistry enact that:

**Section 1.** The UNC School of Dentistry is to establish an educational track for internationally trained dentists to receive their U.S. dental degree at UNC, pending approval from the Commission on Dental Accreditation. Beginning in January each year, admitted students will have six months of calibration prior to enrolling in the standard Doctor of Dental Surgery curriculum as a part of that fall's current third-year Doctor of Dental Surgery class.

The Faculty further charge the Constitution and Bylaws Committee to draft changes to the Constitution of the School of Dentistry to appropriately form and define this track, with the understanding that such changes must be approved by the Faculty in order to take effect.

**Section 2.** The changes outlined in Section 1, if approved, are to be effective by a deadline that permits student applications during summer 2018 with enrollment beginning Jan. 2019, and are to be reflected in the school's Bylaws (Article IV, Section 4) at that time.
